Treasures Report:

Current Booster Club Balance: \$4,203.29

No July 2010 statement received from the bank due to inactivity.

Expenditures in 2009= \$9,485.00

(Note: Freshman parents fundraised on their own for the 2009 season, which is not the case for the 2010 season. Booster Club contributed only \$600 to the 2009 freshman Banquet . In 2010, Booster will need to pay for freshman player and coaches gifts and the banquet.)

Expected fundraisers for 2010-2011 are: Tiger Gear, Football program ads, pie sales, Tiger Prowl, and the silent auction at the end of the year banquet.

Insurance has been paid for the year along with the P.O. Box and the filing fee.

Paul Hemschoot is requesting to be taken off the bank account for signing checks. Mary will follow-up with this issue.

CJ. has requested to step down from the presidency due to job commitments. He is requesting to remain the chairman of fundraising and will work with his wife Linda. The Booster club members present agreed to the change and elected Mary Farr President along with Jody Panian to help Mary. Both Mary and Jody will continue in their duties for the time as Secretary and Treasurer.

Reports of Committees:

Fundraising: CJ

CJ wants to investigate and plan a poker party this fall. He will try to find someone to host this event, either at their home or a rented place.
